Tech Talk



The Latest in House Batteries

I'm in need of new house batteries. Since we have an all-electric fridge so I was looking to increase capacity to make it through a couple of days of dry camping if possible. The popular thing has been to use two 6 volt golf cart batteries, to give about 230 Amp-hours (Ahrs) of capacity. But lead-acid batteries have a lot of drawbacks, biggest of which they are heavy and if drawn below 50% capacity their overall life goes way down.

Enter Lithium Iron Phosphate (LiFePO4 or LFP) batteries. They are 1/3 the weight, can be discharged down to 20% (or less) several thousand times and can be recharged much faster. A single 100Ahr LFP battery is basically equivalent to the two golf cart lead acid batteries. They have a couple of disadvantages though, such as requiring a different charge voltage than lead acid and they cannot be charged below freezing. I already have a charger (converter) that is LFP compatible and we don't camp in the winter.

The other big disadvantage is upfront cost. I've been following LFP batteries for a while now and costs are falling. Typically, a 100Ahr LFP battery was over \$1,000Cdn. You can buy them direct from overseas (where they are all made anyway), for much less money but you are taking your chances with quality and warranty issues. Last fall I

found some guys in Alberta who sourced a reliable manufacturer and had good prices. I emailed them and talked to them on the phone and they seemed to be on the ball. So this spring I looked them up again and found their 100Ahr battery is now \$450Cdn. This is a price I could live with, so I ordered two of them for 200Ahr of capacity. I will receive these sometime in mid May, so about the time you read this.



I'll need to rewire a few things in the meantime so I'm ready when they arrive. Because of the different charging voltage and higher charge current, I'm adding a DC to DC charger for charging from the engine alternator. I found a Renogy unit on sale for \$119.



If you are looking at replacing your house batteries in Canada, you can now get into LFP for about the cost of replacing two golf cart batteries. I'll gain some experience with them and be able to report the good and the bad in the next newsletter and in person at the Rallies.
