**Tech Article**

An Electric Parking Brake (EPB) for the GMC Motorhome.

The holding power of the OEM parking brake on the GMC was

marginal from the start, and most rear disk upgrades with a parking brake did not fair much better. Add to that the parking cable brake system complicated and subject to corrosion. It also required careful adjustment for optimal operation. Many upgrades have been tried on the **GMC** with varying dearees of success. Enter the Electric Parking Brake (EPB). These are not a new have invention and standard equipment on higher-end automobiles for many years. Manufacturer ZF recently announced they had surpassed their 200 millionth EPB unit. The calipers required larger the GMC motorhome application became available when truck manufacturers started making EPB as an option. We have designed and successfully tested a GMC motorhome with an EPB system holding on a 15% grade (8.5 degrees). The test bed maxed out at 8.6 degrees of inclination. Further testing is required to find the maximum holding angle. Features and Benefits:

- Simple ON/OFF switch control with visual and option audible alert that the EPB is ON;
