Club Meeting Decisions

At an Executive meeting held during the September Rally last Fall, two items were discussed by the Committee and approved. They are repeated in this Newsletter in case someone missed it. The first has to do with Rally Masters and their paying of rally costs. Starting in 2025, Rally Masters will no longer be required to pay rally fees for the rally they are organizing. Rally charges, mainly for food, are typically in the \$100 - \$150 range per couple. Going forward the Club will cover these costs for all Rally Masters. Please note, this does not include camping fees and/or other special activity fees like a boat cruise, bus rental, activity admission fee, etc.

The second item relates to the \$10.00 fee per coach currently beina charged to members attending rallies. This fee was designed to cover such things as postage, and printing, incidentals related to organizing a rally. This is no longer required so the going forward Club will eliminate the requirement for Rally Masters to collect the \$10.00 fee for each coach attending a rally.

Tech Article

Have you joined the new **GMCmotorhome.org** forum yet?

Dating back to the '90s, many GMCer's communicated with each other using an email list called Members could post GMCNet. messages to one email address, and it would be resent out to all members of the list. It wasn't fancy, but it got the job done. Later, in the early 2000's, a web-based forum page setup where was up messages posted to the email list would show up on the forum and vice versa with a few short comings.


This worked very well for many years, but then smart phones and Social Media came along. The GMCNet does not display well on smart phones and many people were already using social media

(think Facebook). So participation in GMCNet started to wain in favour of social media. Trouble is social media sites do not lend themselves well to detailed questions and answers. Nor are they good at archiving information and searching for it later.

Back in 2019, a new GMCer who was tech savvy, recognized this shortcoming and started a new Forum website called "GMCmotorhome.org". It is based on a modern forum platform giving younger users the look and feel they desire. It is also compatible with smaller screen smartphones and tablets.

GMCmotorhome.org allows posting of photos and videos as well as documents (pdf's etc) in messages. There is a Resource section for "How To" documents and Presentations as well as a media section for posting photos and videos. You can also send and receive Private Messages.

Recently the entire **GMCNet** archive of postings covering 1998-2022 comprising of over 88,000 threads and 570,000 messages, imported has been to GMCmotorhome.org is and completely searchable. Currently the information from the GMC motorhome EFI Google Group is in the process of being imported.
